Mayor Glenn Wunderlich presided

1. Council Members present Norma Bukoveckas, Ray Bukoveckas, Steve Nelson, and Dave Widhalm.

Town Staff present Andrea Bowie, Deputy Clerk/ Treasurer

Mayor Wunderlich brought the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

2. Mayor Wunderlich led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Some of the highlights include: 2 of Valier's Deputies are out on family medical leave, traffic stops, 2 reports of cows out, vehicle lock-out, 6 medical emergency and 1 lift assist, 3 burn permits, 3 welfare checks, 1 missing person, 2 abandoned vehicles, 1 missing person, and 1 harassment call.

7. Public Works Report.

The Public Works report was submitted in a written form as follows: These are the highlights for the Public Works Department for the month of February 2019. The Town pumped 1,093,300 gallons of water for the month, for an average of 39,046 gallons per day. Bulk water sold 48,130 gallons for the month. The water sample was good for the month. The water levels in the wells are above average for this time of the year. Our Wastewater Treatment Facility sample results for the month was good.
