Mayor Glenn Wunderlich presided.

Mayor Wunderlich brought the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

1. Mayor Wunderlich led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Wunderlich called for any corrections or additions to the July 14, 2025, regular town council meeting minutes. None heard. Alderman S. 2. Public Comment.

Josh Reed, school superintendent for the Valier Public Schools, gave a brief update on what's been going on at the school and some upcoming events. 5. Public Works Report.

Josh Clifford gave the water report. The Town pumped 4,516,000 gallons of water for the month, for an average of 145,677 gallons per day. Bulk water sold 83,230 gallons for month.

The water sample was good for the month. The water levels in the wells are about average for this time of year.

6. Mayor Wunderlich presented the council with Resolution #209 USDA Loan for \$210,000.00. Mayor Wunderlich called for a vote to adopt the resolution. After a brief discussion, Mayor Wunderlich called for a vote on the motion. Alderman Tomsheck made a motion to approve the resolution. Alderman S. Nelson second. Motion carried unanimously.

7. Mayor Wunderlich presented the council with Resolution #210 USDA Loan for \$250,000.00. Mayor Wunderlich called for a vote to adopt the resolution. After a brief discussion, Mayor Wunderlich called for a vote on the motion. Alderwoman J. Nelson made a motion to approve the resolution. Alderman S. Nelson second. Motion carried unanimously.

8. Mayor Wunderlich suspended the regular Town Council meeting and opened the public hearing @7:26P.M. to go over the preliminary budget for Fy 25-26. After a brief discussion, Mayor Wunderlich called for a vote on the motion. Alderwoman J. Nelson made a motion to approve the preliminary budget. Alderman Tomsheck second. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Wunderlich closed the public hearing and reopened the regular Town Council meeting @ 8:33 P.M.
